## **Mobile Deposit Terms and Conditions**

This Mobile Deposit User Agreement ("Agreement") contains the terms and conditions for the use of Hendricks County Bank and Trust Company (HCBT) Mobile Deposit services that HCBT ("bank", "us", "our", or "we") may provide to you ("you," or "User"). Other agreements you have entered into with HCBT, including the Online Banking and Mobile Banking disclosures, as applicable to your HCBT account(s), are incorporated by reference and made a part of this Agreement.

- 1. Services. HCBT's Mobile Deposit services ("Services") are designed to allow you to make deposits to your checking or savings accounts from home or other remote locations by capturing the image of a check and delivering the images and associated deposit information to HCBT.
- 2. Acceptance of these Terms. Your use of the Services constitutes your acceptance of this Agreement. This Agreement is subject to change at any time. We will notify you of any material change via e-mail, text message, or on our website by providing a link to the revised Agreement. Your continued use of the Services will indicate your consent to be bound by the revised Agreement. Further, HCBT reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to change, modify, add, or remove portions from the Services. Your continued use of the Services will indicate your acceptance of any such changes to the Services.
- **3. Limitations of Service.** When using the Mobile Deposit Service, you may experience technical or other difficulties that are beyond the control of HCBT or there may be times when the Mobile Deposit service is unavailable. We cannot assume responsibility for any technical or other difficulties or any resulting damages that you may incur. Some of the Services have qualification requirements, and we reserve the right to change the qualifications at any time without prior notice. We reserve the right to change, suspend or discontinue the Services, in whole or in part, or your use of the Services, in whole or in part, immediately and at any time without prior notice to you.

**4. Hardware and Software.** In order to use the Services, you must obtain and maintain, at your expense, compatible hardware and software as specified by HCBT. HCBT is not responsible for any third-party software you may need to use the Services. Any such software is accepted by you as is and is subject to the terms and conditions of the software agreement you enter directly with the third-party software provider at time of download and installation.

- **5. Fees.** We reserve the rights to impose and/or modify the fee for the Service at our discretion. In addition, your wireless carrier may assess fees for data or text messaging services. Please consult your wireless plan or provider for more details. All telephone and wireless charges associated with Mobile Banking are your responsibility.
- **6. Eligibility.** Mobile deposit is available to most customers that have a checking or saving account that is in good standing and open for at least 30 days, have an online banking profile, and have installed the Mobile Banking application to a qualified mobile device.
- **7. Eligible items.** You agree to image and deposit only "checks" as that term is defined in Federal Reserve Regulation CC ("Reg. CC"). When the image of the check transmitted to HCBT is converted to an Image Replacement Document for subsequent presentment and collection, it shall thereafter be deemed an "item" within the meaning of Articles 3 and 4 of the Uniform Commercial Code.

Items that can be deposited via Mobile Deposit are checks payable to the account owner or joint account owners that have been properly endorsed with the appropriate signature(s), the words "For Mobile Deposit Only", and that day's date.

NOTE: Any check that you attempt to deposit using HCBT Mobile Deposit is subject to review by HCBT. We reserve the right to reject any item for deposit for any reason and will not be liable to you. In such a case, you will need to deposit that item via other means, such as visiting a HCBT office in person.

You agree that you will not scan and deposit any of the following types of checks or other items which shall be considered ineligible items:

Checks payable to any person or entity other than the person or entity that owns the account that the check is being deposited into.

- Checks containing an alteration on the front of the check or item, or which you know or suspect, or should know or suspect, are fraudulent or otherwise not authorized by the owner of the account on which the check is drawn.
- Checks payable jointly, unless deposited into an account in the name of all payees.
- Checks previously converted to a substitute check, as defined in Reg. CC.
- Checks drawn on a financial institution located outside the United States.
- Checks that are remotely created checks, as defined in Reg. CC.
- Checks not payable in United States currency.
- Checks dated more than 6 months prior to the date of deposit.
- Checks or items prohibited by the bank's current procedures relating to the services or which are otherwise not acceptable under the terms of your HCBT account.
- Checks payable on sight or payable through Drafts, as defined in Reg. CC.
- Checks with any endorsement on the back other than that specified in this agreement.
- Checks that have previously been submitted through the Service or through a remote deposit capture service offered at any other financial institution.
- Checks that have previously been deposited or negotiated in any way via any method at HCBT or any other financial institution.
- Checks that have been previously returned or re-deposited items.
- Bonds.
- **8. Endorsements and Procedures.** You agree to restrictively endorse any item transmitted through the Services with the appropriate signature(s), the words "For Mobile Deposit Only", and that day's date or as otherwise instructed by HCBT. You agree to follow any and all other procedures and instructions for use of the Services as HCBT may establish from time to time.

- 9. Receipt of Items. We reserve the right to reject any item transmitted through the Services, at our discretion, without liability to you. We are not responsible for items we do not receive or for images that are dropped during transmission. An image of an item shall be deemed received when you receive a confirmation from HCBT that we have received and accepted the image. Receipt of such confirmation does not mean that the transmission was error free, complete or will be considered a deposit and credited to your account. We further reserve the right to charge back to your account at any time, any item that we subsequently determine was not an eligible item. You agree that the Bank is not liable for any loss, costs, or fees you may incur as a result of our chargeback of an ineligible item.

- 10. Availability of Funds. In general, any item transmitted, received, and accepted via the Service by the Bank's stated 3:30 pm ET deadline will be considered deposited on that business day and subject to the Funds Availability disclosure provided during account opening. Otherwise, we will consider that the deposit was made on the next business day we are open. A business day is Monday through Friday, excluding Federal holidays and as otherwise posted in our offices. Funds deposited using the Services will generally be made available on the first business day after the day of deposit. We reserve the right to place a hold on funds deposited through the service as described in our "Funds Availability Notice" given to you when you opened your account with HCBT.
- 11. Disposal of Transmitted Items. Upon your receipt of a confirmation from HCBT that we have successfully received and accepted your deposit, you agree to store the check in a secure location for 14 days. After 14 days, and after you have confirmed the deposited funds have been correctly applied to your account, you agree to destroy the check preferably by shredding or marking it "VOID". You will be liable for checks that are presented more than once. During the time the retained check is available, you agree to promptly provide it to HCBT upon request.
- 12. Deposit Limits. We reserve the right to and may establish limits on the dollar amount and/or number of items or deposits from time to time. If you attempt to initiate a deposit in excess of these limits, we may reject your deposit. If we permit you to make a deposit in excess of these limits, such deposit will still be subject to

the terms of this Agreement, and we will not be obligated to allow such a deposit at other times.

13. Presentment. The manner in which the items are cleared, presented for payment, and collected shall be in HCBT's sole discretion subject to the agreements governing your account.

- **14. Errors.** You agree to notify HCBT of any suspected errors regarding items deposited through the Services immediately, and in no event later than 60 days after the applicable HCBT account statement is sent. Unless you notify HCBT within 60 days, such statement regarding all deposits made through the Services shall be deemed correct, and you are prohibited from bringing a claim against HCBT for such alleged error. You can contact us by calling 317-852-2268 or visiting any HCBT office.
- **15. Errors in Transmission.** By using the Services, you accept the risk that an item may be intercepted or misdirected during transmission. HCBT bears no liability to you or others for any such intercepted or misdirected items or information disclosed through such errors.
- **16. Image Quality.** The image of an item transmitted to HCBT using the Services must be legible, as determined in the sole discretion of HCBT. Without limiting the foregoing, the image quality of the items must comply with the requirements established from time to time by HCBT, the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve Board, or any other regulatory agency, clearinghouse or association.

## 17. User Warranties and Indemnification. You warrant to HCBT that:

- You will only transmit eligible items.
- You will not transmit duplicate items.
- You will not re-deposit or re-present the original item.
- All information you provide to HCBT is accurate and true.
- You will comply with this Agreement and all applicable rules, laws, and regulations.
- You are not aware of any factor which may impair the collectability of the item.
- You agree to indemnify and hold harmless HCBT from any loss for breach of this warranty provision.

**18. Cooperation with Investigations.** You agree to cooperate with us in the investigation of unusual transactions, poor quality transmissions, and resolution of customer claims, including by providing, upon request and without further cost, any originals or copies of items deposited through the Service in your possession and your records relating to such items and transmissions.

- **19. Termination.** We may terminate this Agreement at any time, for any reason, and without notice. This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect unless and until it is terminated by us. Without limiting the foregoing, this Agreement may be terminated if you breach any term of this Agreement, if you use the Services for any unauthorized or illegal purposes or you use the Services in a manner inconsistent with the terms of your HCBT account agreement or any other agreement with us.
- **20. Enforceability.** We may waive enforcement of any provision of this Agreement. No waiver of a breach of this Agreement shall constitute a waiver of any prior or subsequent breach of the Agreement. Any such waiver shall not affect our rights with respect to any other transaction or to modify the terms of this Agreement. In the event that any provision of this Agreement shall be deemed to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable to any extent, the remainder of the Agreement shall not be impaired or otherwise affected and shall continue to be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 21. Ownership & License. You agree that HCBT retains all ownership and proprietary rights in the Services, associated content, technology, and website(s). Your use of the Services is subject to and conditioned upon your complete compliance with this Agreement. Without limiting the effect of the foregoing, any breach of this Agreement immediately terminates your right to use the Services. Without limiting the restriction of the foregoing, you may not use the Services (i) in any anticompetitive manner, (ii) for any purpose which would be contrary to HCBT's business interest, or (iii) to HCBT's actual or potential economic disadvantage in any aspect. You may use the Services only in accordance with this Agreement. You may not copy, reproduce, distribute or create derivative works from the content and agree not to reverse engineer or reverse compile any of the technology used to provide the Services.

We make no warranty that the services (i) will meet your requirements, (ii) will be uninterrupted, timely, secure, or error-free, (iii) the results that may be obtained from the service will be accurate or reliable, and (iv) any errors in the services or technology will be corrected.

You agree that we will not be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, consequential or exemplary damages, including, but not limited to damages for loss of profits, goodwill, use, data or other losses resulting from the use or the inability to use the services incurred by you or any third party arising from or related to the use of, inability to use, or the termination of the use of this service, regardless of the form of action or claim (whether contract, tort, strict liability or otherwise), even if HCBT has been informed of the possibility thereof.
